The Illinois Water Environment Association (IWEA) was recently selected to host the U.S. competition of the 2011 Stockholm Junior Water Prize. IWEA will help organize, fund and/or volunteer for such activities as local transportation, signage, a teachers' learning event, sight-seeing opportunities and souvenirs.

2011 Event in Chicago

It is estimated that more than 150 students, teachers & judges will gather in Chicago at the Palmer House from June 23-25 where state-level winners will compete for national honors. The national winners will then compete internationally in Stockholm, Sweden.

International Water Resources Competition

The Stockholm Junior Water Prize is an international science competition that challenges high school students to address the issues facing our water resources. More than 30 countries participate in this international competition which brings together some of the world's brightest young scientists.

About the Projects

The U.S. competition is open to all high school students with projects aimed at improving the quality of life through enhancement of water quality, water resources management, water protection or water treatment. For example this year's winner, Rebecca Ye will represent the USA at the international competition in Stockholm, Sweden with her research on a proposed technique to combine the sciences of microbiology and nanotechnology to create a biosensor capable of rapid identification strains of pathogenic bacteria E. Coli.
