The National Competition

The Stockholm Junior Water Prize was founded by the Stockholm Water Foundation in 1997.

The Crown Princess of Sweden is the patron of the prize and presents the international award each year.

The U.S. has participated in this program since the prize was founded. The national program is managed by the Water Environment Federation with support from ITT Corporation and Delta Airlines. WEF member associations select the state winners from hundreds of entries across the county. The member associations also help organize the national competition.

The U.S. competition is open to all high school students with projects aimed at improving the quality of life through enhancement of water

The Stockholm Junior Water Prize is the most prestigious international youth award for high school water science research projects.

Its purpose is to increase students' interest in water-related issues and research and to sensitize them – as future leaders – to global water challenges.
